- The Global Partnership on Artificial Intelligence (GPAI) Summit 2023 will be held in New Delhi, India from December 12 to 14.
- The summit aims to foster international cooperation on various Al issues and will include a Ministerial Council on December 13.



ABOUT

- The event will bring together experts from governments, international organizations, industry, academia, and civil society to discuss responsible AI, data governance, the future of work, innovation and commercialization.
- The summit will also feature a Global Al Expo, showcasing Al progress and engaging in discussions, along with various side events such as industry panel discussions, workshops and a research symposium.

BACKGROUND

Australia, Canada, the European Union, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, the Republic of Korea, Mexico, New Zealand, Singapore, Slovenia, the United Kingdom and the United States are the founding members.

- ➤ GPAI receives backing from a Secretariat, situated at the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) in Paris.
- It has the opportunity to leverage the OECD's knowledge in Al policy and its role as a pioneer in establishing the inaugural global standard for reliable Al, known as the OECD Principles on Artificial Intelligence.

The OECD works as the permanent observer to the GPAI's governing bodies.

MERA GAON, MERI DHAROHAR




CONTEXT

OBJECTIVES

INFORMATION CATEGORIES

- ➤ Data is collected under seven categories-
 - Arts and Crafts: Villages known for unique local arts and crafts.
 - Environment: Villages practicing sustainable living and environmental conservation.
 - Education: Villages linked to India's textual and scriptural traditions.

- Epic: Villages associated with stories from epics like the Ramayana and Mahabharata.
- Historic: Villages with significant local or national historical connections.
- Architectural Heritage: Villages notable for unique architectural styles and heritage.
- Accessibility: The information will be accessible to a wide audience, promoting cultural awareness and preservation.

SIGNIFICANCE

➤ By documenting these diverse aspects of village life, the MGMD program aims not only to preserve this rich cultural heritage but also to promote it, ensuring that future generations can learn about and appreciate the depth and diversity of Indian culture.

GLOBAL RIVER CITIES ALLIANCE (GRCA)



CONTEXT

The National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) has signed a Memorandum of Common Purpose (MoCP) with the Mississippi River Cities and Towns Initiative (MRCTI) during COP28 in the United Arab Emirates.



FOCUS AREAS

- Comprehensive water monitoring programs.
- ➤ Sharing best practices for re-naturing urban areas.
- Restoring aquatic ecosystems for sustainable urban development.
 - Emphasis on Green Spaces: The program includes restoring urban forests and lakes connected to rivers, highlighting the importance of green spaces.

ABOUT RIVER CITIES ALLIANCE (RCA)

- ➤ Initiated in 2021 by NMCG under the Ministry of Jal Shakti.
- ➤ Association with the National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA) under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).
- A platform for Indian river cities for sustainable urban river management.
- Initially comprised 142 Indian River cities and Aarhus, Denmark.

ABOUT MISSISSIPPI RIVER CITIES AND TOWNS INITIATIVE (MRCTI)

- > Represents 124 cities/towns along the Mississippi River, USA.
- Focuses on economic and environmental security along the Mississippi River Corridor since 2012.
- >Empowers member mayors for effective local initiatives.

ABOUT NATIONAL MISSION FOR CLEAN GANGA(NMCG)

- >A registered society under the Societies Registration Act 1860.
 - Aimed at pollution abatement and rejuvenation of the Ganga River.
 - Operates with a two-tier management structure.
 - Responsible for implementing the Namami Ganga scheme.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE MOCP

The agreement for the Global River Cities Alliance (GRCA) highlights the key role of international cooperation in sustainable river management and urban development, through the collaboration of NMCG and MRCTI.

CLIMATE CHANGE PERFORMANCE INDEX(CCPI) 2024

➤ India further improved it's global CCPI ranking by securing 7th position(last year, it was 8th).


ABOUT

- The Climate Change Performance Index (CCPI)

 2024 is a monitoring tool released by

 Germanwatch, that tracks the climate mitigation

 progress of 63 countries and the European Union,
 responsible for more than 90% of global emissions.
- The index assesses each country's performance in four categories: GHG Emissions (40% of the overall ranking), Renewable Energy (20%), Energy Use (20%) and Climate Policy (20%).



KEY FINDINGS FROM THE CCPI, 2024

- Top performers: Denmark, Estonia and the Philippines are the topranked countries in the CCPI 2024.
- ➤G20 performance: Only three G20 members (India, Germany and the EU) are among the 'high' overall performers, while 15 G20 countries receive an overall 'low' or 'very low' rating.

- ➤Oil-producing countries: The United Arab Emirates (UAE), Iran, and Saudi Arabia form the bottom trio of the CCPI 2024, ranking 65th to 67th.
- China and the US: China remains at the 51st place among the 'low' performing countries, while the US stays at the bottom.
- Renewable energy boom: Despite a boom in renewable energy in many countries, the world is still no closer to Paris climate goals until fossil fuels decline drastically.
