

JAMMU & KASHMIR RESERVATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2023



CONTEXT

- The Jammu and Kashmir Reservation (Amendment) Bill, 2023 was passed in the Lok Sabha on December 6, 2023.
- The bill aims to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 which provides for reservation in jobs and admission in professional institutions for members of Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes and other socially and educationally backward classes.



KEY CHANGES PROPOSED

The amendment suggests a change in the nomenclature of a section of people previously described as "weak and underprivileged classes" (social castes)" to "other backward classes".

REPRESENTATION IN LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

- The bill also proposes to increase the total number of seats in the Jammu and Kashmir legislative assembly, with specific reservations for Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes
- It also aims to provide representation in the Legislative Assembly to Kashmiri migrants and displaced persons from Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK).

SURGE IN CRUDE OIL PRODUCTION IN ASSAM



CONTEXT

Assam has experienced a significant surge in crude oil production, totaling 4.2 million tonnes and constituting a noteworthy 14.3% share of the country's production.



The major exploration and production player in Assam is Oil India Limited (OIL), which has drilled over 1250 wells and operates a 1157 km fully automated crude oil pipeline that transports crude from its fields in Guwahati, Bongaigaon and Barauni.


Similarly, the state has excelled in natural gas production, corresponding to a 14.3% share in the national natural gas production.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ®

- The Digboi Refinery, established in 1901, has a capacity to refine nearly 500 barrels of oil a day.
- Assam has the highest number of refineries in the country, a testimony to the amount of oil in the region

Numaligarh Refinery expansion project, North East Gas Grid, Paradip-Numaligarh crude oil pipeline, NRL Bio refinery and the 2G refinery of 185 klpd capacity at Numaligarh (which will produce Ethanol from Bamboo) are some of the other interesting prospects taken by the government in order to reduce the dependence on the imports.

HOMEN BORGOHAIN: A STALWART OF ASSAMESE LITERATURE

- ➤ He was born on December 7, 1932, and passed away on May 12, 2021.
- ➤ Borgohain is celebrated as a prominent figure in contemporary Assamese literature, known for his diverse talents as a poet, novelist, short story writer, essayist and preeminent journalist.

- He edited various significant weekly and daily newspapers such as Saptahik Nilachal, Asam Bani, Amor Asom, and Niyomiya Barta, as well as literary and cultural magazines like Sutrodhar and Satsori.
- ➤ His work in literature earned him prestigious accolades like the Srimanta Sankardev Award and the Assam Valley Literary Award.

- >He was honored with the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1978 for his novel "Pita Putra,"
- ➤ Borgohain served as the chair of the Asom Sahitya Sabha, a prominent literary society, twice in 2001 and 2002
- ➤ Homen Borgohain's life and work exemplify a commitment to journalistic integrity and literary excellence, profoundly influencing Assamese society and culture.

 Meghalaya has recently been honored with the Geographical Indication (GI) tag for several of its unique products




LAKADONG TURMERIC
