

# MARATHA MILITARY LANDSCAPES



#### CONTEXT

➤ India has nominated the "Maratha Military Landscapes of India" for inclusion in the UNESCO World Heritage List for the years 2024-25.

#### **KEY FACT**

- These landscapes highlight the strategic military capabilities of the Maratha empire during the period from the 17th to the 19th centuries.
- Out of over 390 forts in Maharashtra, 12 representative forts have been chosen for the nomination.

Developed under Maratha ruler Shivaji Maharaj from 1670 CE, these forts continued to be developed by subsequent rulers until 1818.

- ➤ The nomination is based on three criteria: exhibiting a unique cultural tradition, featuring outstanding military architectural ensembles, and directly representing Maratha military heritage.
- India currently has 42 UNESCO World Heritage sites.

- The reliable Geosynchronous Satellite Launch
  Vehicle Mk-II (GSLV-F14) has been selected for the satellite's orbiting

➤ Equipped with an Imager, Sounder, Data Relay Transponder (DRT), and Search & Rescue transponder, it will scan the earth in multiple bands, offering detailed updates on cloud parameters, snow cover, sea surface temperatures, and soil moisture.
